Winter Parking Regulations – Ordinance Chapter 3.03

Commencing December 1 and ending April 1, no person shall park or leave standing any vehicle, between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., on the even-numbered side of the street on the odd-numbered calendar days; and, on the odd-numbered side of the street on the even-numbered calendar days; except as posted otherwise. Fines are \$25.
