## **Answers Regarding Culligan Water Notice**

There was a Culligan Water Notice sent out by Total Water of Baraboo discussing Nitrates found in drinking water. It was referenced that Nitrates were found in private wells in the Village of Rock Springs. We filed a consumer complaint with Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection. In the end, the Village was informed the high Nitrate test result came from a private well on Ableman Road and in fact never came from any well within the Village of Rock Springs or the Village of Rock Springs water system.

## Now Accepting ACH as a Utility Payment Option

An ACH payment will allow your payment to be pulled directly out of your checking or savings account each month. Payments will be processed on or around the last Tuesday of each month.
