## Village Awarded CDBG-PF Grant

The Village of Rock Springs was awarding a Community Development Block Grant for \$500,000 for infrastructure and street improvements.

CDBG – Public Facilities (CDBG-PF) Funds – These funds help support infrastructure and facility projects for communities. Some examples of eligible projects include improvements, repairs, or expansions of streets, drainage systems, water and sewer systems, sidewalks, and community centers. Grants are limited to projects that, if implemented, would meet a CDBG National Objective.

The Village of Rock Springs will be using these funds to update water and sewer infrastructure on Montgomery Street, Hill Street, Bender Street, & Smythe Street. New curb, gutter and asphalt will also be installed on Montgomery Street, Hill Street, & Smythe Street.

Engineering work for this project will start soon. The Village hopes to start construction in Spring of 2018 and complete construction by Fall of 2018. Stay tuned for information regarding a public informational hearing.

## Snow Removal - Ordinance Chapter 6.02

SNOW & ICE REMOVAL. The owner, occupant or person in charge of each and every building or structure or unoccupied lot in the Village fronting or abutting any street shall clean, or cause to be cleaned, the sidewalk in front of or adjoining each such building or unoccupied lot of snow or ice to the width of such sidewalk within twenty-four (24) hours after the cessation of a snowstorm. When the ice has formed on any sidewalk so that is cannot be immediately removed, the person herein referred to shall keep the same sprinkled with salt or sand. After twenty-four (24) hours of no shoveling, a warning will be put on the owner or occupant's door to remove the snow within twelve (12) hours. If not done, the snow and ice will be removed by Public Works and billed according to paragraph (6a) below.

**NO DEPOSIT ON STREET.** No person shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, any snow or ice taken and removed from his premises or elsewhere upon any sidewalk, alley, parkway, public place or street in the Village. Snow shall not be piled at or near intersections so as to obstruct the view of pedestrians or operators of motor vehicles.

VILLAGE TO REMOVE. The deposit of any snow or ice upon any sidewalk, alley or street of the Village contrary to the provisions of this section shall be and is declared to be a nuisance act and, in addition to the penalty provided for violation of this section, the Village may summarily remove any snow so deposited and cause the cost of said removal to be charged to the owner of the property from which said snow or ice has been removed. If not paid within 30 days, such charge shall be extended upon the current of next tax roll as a change for current services, as provided in 66.60(16), Wis. Stats.

# Winter Parking Regulations – Ordinance Chapter 3.03

Commencing December 1 and ending April 1, no person shall park or leave standing any vehicle, between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., on the even-numbered side of the street on the odd-numbered calendar days; and, on the odd-numbered side of the street on the even-numbered calendar days; except as posted otherwise.
