## Notice of Rate Increase

### Sewer Customer of the Rock Springs Municipal Utility

Rates for general service will increase 15 percent on January 1, 2020. The increase is necessary to reduce the existing deficiency in present rates. The effect of the increase for some selected customers is shown below.

Industrial	2"	150,000	\$1,179.49	\$1,356.38

We are working with FEMA to close out our 2018 flood damage dollars. Street & Park damage from the 2018 flood will be projects that will be addressed in late fall and early spring once we are awarded the estimated FEMA dollars.

\*Fees for Dogs: Male or Female \$10 Spayed or Neutered \$5

\*\*Sauk County Ordinance 27.05 requires all dogs over 5 months be licensed.

### 2020 Garbage/Recycling

We will stay with Lenorud Services for the 2020-2022 Calendar years. Garbage & Recycling will continue to be picked up on Friday morning. A yearly charge of \$162.36 (per residential unit) will be added to your tax bill. Due to increased cost, the Spring Clean Up will no longer take place. However, the Village is looking into other disposal options and a possible appliance/battery pick up sometime in the spring. More details to come in 2020.
