

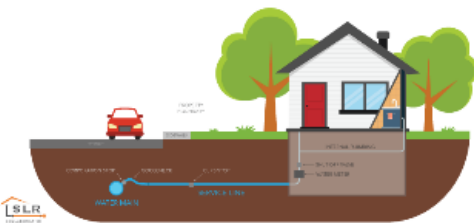

Village Ordinance: Chapter 3 ~ WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS

Commencing December 1 and ending April 1, no person shall park or leave standing any vehicle, between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., on the even-numbered side of the street on the odd-numbered calendar days; and, on the odd-numbered side of the street on the even-numbered calendar days; except as posted otherwise.

Village Ordinance: Chapter 6 ~ SNOW REMOVAL

(5) SNOW & ICE REMOVAL. The owner, occupant or person in charge of each and every building or structure or unoccupied lot in the Village fronting or abutting any street shall clean, or cause to be cleaned, the sidewalk in front of or adjoining each such building or unoccupied lot of snow or ice to the width of such sidewalk within twenty-four (24) hours after the cessation of a snowstorm. When the ice has formed on any sidewalk so that it cannot be immediately removed, the person herein referred to shall keep the same sprinkled with salt or sand. After twenty-four (24) hours of no shoveling, a warning will be put on the owner or occupant’s door to remove the snow within twelve (12) hours. If not done, the snow and ice will be removed by Public Works and billed according to paragraph (6a) below.

(6) NO DEPOSIT ON STREET. No person shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, any snow or ice taken and removed from his premises or elsewhere upon any sidewalk, alley, parkway, public place or street in the Village. Snow shall not be piled at or near intersections so as to obstruct the view of pedestrians or operators of motor vehicles.

(6a) VILLAGE TO REMOVE. The deposit of any snow or ice upon any sidewalk, alley or street of the Village contrary to the provisions of this section shall be and is declared to be a nuisance act and, in addition to the penalty provided for violation of this section, the Village may summarily remove any snow so deposited and cause the cost of said removal to be charged to the owner of the property from which said snow or ice has been removed. If not paid within 30 days, such charge shall be extended upon the current of next tax roll as a charge for current services, as provided in 66.60(16), Wis. Stats.

2023 Tax Bills

Tax bills for the 2023 year should be in the mail no later than December 15th.
