Village Clean Up Letters

The Village will be sending clean up notices to homeowners within the next month. Chapter 4.05 discusses public nuisance and storage of junk items. Please take the time to clean up your yards to avoid getting a letter. *For a violation of any section of the Rock Springs Code of Ordinances for which there is no specific penalty provision provided the penalty shall be not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense together with the costs of prosecution. For a continuing violation, each day shall constitute a separate offense.*

Friendly reminder on our Weed & Grass Ordinance

Ordinance Regarding Weeds & Grass

10.06 WEED CONTROL (1) NOXIOUS WEEDS AND RANK GROWTH PROHIBITED. No owner or occupant or any lot or parcel shall allow such property to become overgrown with any weeds or grass so as to constitute a public nuisance as defined in Section 4.05(8) of this chapter.

- (4) ENFORCEMENT. If a property owner fails to control the growth of vegetation on his property, the Weed Commissioner shall provide the property owner with written notice as to this fact. The notice shall be mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, to the address of the property owner as shown on the Village tax rolls. If such owner fails to abate this nuisance within six (6) days after the date of mailing of the notice, the Weed Commissioner shall take action to abate such public nuisance.
- (5) COSTS. If the Village causes a nuisance to be removed as provided above, the actual cost thereof, together with an administrative fee equal to ten percent (10%) of the actual cost, shall be charged to the property owner. If such charges are not paid by November 15th of the year in which they are billed, such charges, together with an additional administrative fee for collection equal to ten percent (10%) of the total of such charges and fees, shall be extended on the next succeeding tax roll as a tax charged against the property affected and collected in the same manner as are other taxes, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.98
